2023 Annual Review

Background

In 2019 a five year accessibility plan was created with input from Senior Leadership, Lead Manager and members of the Wellness Committee. Challenging to implement all desired changes due to aged infrastructure, physical layout, and limited financial resources. Progress is reviewed each year with the most recent submission completed December 2023. Highlights included in appendix A.

Assessment/Impact

Additional areas under review in all areas for improved Accessibility include:

- Accessible washrooms replace toilets with higher toilets so that they are wheelchair accessible. Height of mirrors (place on slant). Access to sink, paper towels, soap.
- Elevators visually impaired know they have reached their desired level, auditory
- Change rooms equipped with a bench/chair for a patient to sit if required
- Signage/Patient/Staff Information Font size,
- Door Knobs –need to change from knob to lever a large number at GWM site are still knob.
- Light switches public/patient areas (GWM motion sensor versus switches)
- Parking Accessible spaces review percentage of Type A and Type B as well as accessible aisles between spots.
- Furniture includes chairs with arms, bariatric seating.
- Elevation changes identify floors and stairwells

A new distinct committee has been initiated with first meeting held January 2024. Priorities of committee include:

- Training/Education for new staff/volunteers
- Annual training for all staff/volunteers
- Review and Update Identified barriers
- Development of next 5 year Plan
- Policies review, etc
