The Medical Radiation Technologist Performs diagnostic and/or therapeutic x-ray procedures, working within scope of practice and maintaining patient confidentiality. Follows all workplace H&S policies and procedures; wears and uses personal protective equipment; ensures deliverance of a clean and safe physical/psychological environment for patients, visitors and staff and reports workplace hazards and concerns. Supports and participates in quality improvement, risk management and patient safety activities department policies and procedures.

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

**Mandatory**

- Successful completion of a recognized program in Medical Imaging undergraduate or degree program, specializing in x-ray imaging.
- Must be registered with the College of Medical Radiation Technologists of Ontario in order to practice.
- Current CPR

**Core:**

- Excellent interpersonal and oral communication skills required to work effectively with other members of the healthcare team and multicultural clientele.
- Good organizational skills required to meet workload demands.
- Demonstrated observation, analytical and decision-making skills to address patient care emergencies, to interpret and prioritize requests.
- Ability to demonstrate and explain technical, patient care and departmental policies/procedures/protocols for training/orientation of staff and others.
- Intermediate reading/writing skills to support patient care and documentation responsibilities.

- Operation of diagnostic imaging equipment as used in clinical application situations.
