The Vascular Protection Clinical Registered Nurse works within the framework of nursing and in collaboration with other members of the healthcare team to provide and enhance professional advanced care for a specific patient population. Services will encompass the full scope of advanced nursing practice (clinical, administrative, education and research blended with expanded function, controlled acts delegated by medicine - medical directives) to meet patient and family centred health needs across the continuum of care/settings.

The Perth and Smiths Falls District Hospital is a full partner with the Regional Stroke Initiative. The Secondary Stroke Prevention Clinic is an integral part of the strategy with the goals of improving time to consultation, testing, treatment and education. Participation in the evaluation of the stroke strategy will be essential.
