

## Diagnostic Imaging (Estimated) Wait Times

Test/Procedure	Estimated Wait Time	How are we doing?
<b>MRI non contrast</b>	Approximately 1-2 weeks	Decrease from four (4) weeks
<b>MRI contrast</b>	Approximately 10 weeks	Increase from six (6) weeks.
<b>Elective General Ultrasound</b>	Approximately six (6) weeks	No change.
<b>Diagnostic Mammography</b>	Approximately one (1) week	Decrease from two (2) weeks.
<b>Ontario Breast Screening Program (OBSP) Mammography</b>	Approximately five (5) months (for called in appointments and requisitions)	No change.
<b>CT urgent/semi-urgent</b>	No wait time for P1, P2	-
<b>Elective CT non contrast</b>	approximately one (1) month	Decrease from five (5) months
<b>Elective CT with contrast</b>	approximately three (3) months	Decrease from five (5) months
<b>General X-ray</b>	approximately one (1) to two (2) weeks. (no wait time for urgent/semi-urgent.)	No change.
<b>Bone Mineral Densitometry (BMD)</b>	Wait time information not available.	BMD tests are performed on a limited basis due to staffing.

<b>Smiths Falls</b>	Next Day	Three (3) days	N/A	24-48 hrs: Five (5) days 7-14 days: Next day

<b>Echocardiography</b>	Approx. one to two (1-2) weeks	Increase from one (1) week.
