MRI	-	Our new service is going live on November 14, 2023.
Elective General Ultrasound	approximately 15 weeks	Increase from 14 weeks.
Echo (Echocardiography)	Approximately 1 week	Decrease from 1.5 weeks.
Diagnostic Mammography	Approximately three (3) weeks	No change.
Ontario Breast Screening Program (OBSP) Mammography	Approximately nine (9) weeks (for called in appointments)	Written/faxed requisitions are longer.
CT urgent/semi-urgent	No wait time for P1, P2	-
Elective CT non contrast	approximately 11 weeks	Increase from 10 weeks.
Elective CT with contrast	approximately 12 weeks	Decrease from 14 weeks.
General X-ray	approximately four (4) weeks <i>(no wait time for urgent/semi-urgent.)</i>	No change.
Bone Mineral Densitometry (BMD)	Wait time information not available.	BMD tests are performed on a limited basis due to staffing issues.

Please note that **out-patient X-ray exams** are scheduled Monday-Friday in Smiths Falls and Monday-Sunday in Perth.
