Summary of Duties:

Reporting to the Interim Chief Nursing Officer, Manager of Professional Practice the Infection Control Professional, Registered Nurse will act as a representative of the Infection Control Team, supporting the implementation and evaluation of the infection prevention and control program for the Perth & Smiths Falls District Hospital.

Responsibilities will include surveillance, epidemiologic investigation, outbreak management, acting as an expert resource internally and externally, education, liaising with external agencies and applying continuous quality improvement principles. Will attend and participate in hospital-related committees. Will be required to develop and maintain a personal education program that supports continuing improvement in the role.
